### BEFORE YOUR TRIP

- **Recommended Reading** to get you in the mood: The House in Amalfi by Elizabeth Adler, The Night Villa by Carol Goodman, The Deep Blue Sea for Beginners by Luanne Rice
- **Passport/Visa Needed:** Your passport needs to be good for 6 months (after departure date)
- **Make Sure to Bring:** A lock! Create a Roman Love Lock: Just like on the Pont des Arts in Paris, some couples attach love locks to the Milvian Bridge. Leave a lock with your initials on it as a symbolic gesture of your love that will stay in Rome forever. Tradition says that once you attach your lock, you should throw the key into the river to seal your commitment, making it "eternal." It's a symbolic and fun way to end the gesture, knowing that your love is "locked" forever.
- **Packing considerations:** Days are still warm during this time, but nights can get start getting cooler (80/65 F). Bring a light jacket, cardigan or scarf for nights! We recommend leaving heals at home and opting for flats or wedges - as there are many cobble streets in the enchanting old villages. For our men, consider packing versatile shoes - comfortable for walking around in the day and can also be worn with a nice pair of khaki slacks for dinner. Packing light is key here - think light fabrics, items you can mix and match with, and less is more! Rooms are small and roads are clunky for dragging around a bunch of large luggage.

### DAY 1: ROME

- **Arrival:** We recommend arriving morning - mid-day on September 17th
- **Transfer to Accommodation:** Taxis are located outside of baggage claim. or a private ride can be found [here](#).
